Responsibilities

- Develop, review, edit, distribute, and communicate age-appropriate Biblical curriculum

- Interact with children and families during Sunday services
- Develop positive relationships with children and their parents.
- Help recruit, train leaders, plan and execute Wednesday night programming for 5th and 6th graders
