As we step into a new season of ministry, we want to take a moment to thank you for your generosity over the past year. Your faithful giving has made an incredible impact—removing obstacles and restoring hope so that more people can find and follow Jesus. Because of your willingness to invest in God's Kingdom, lives have been transformed, families restored, and communities reached with the love of Christ.

With the conclusion of Rise Up in December 2024, we have seen a significant pullback in giving. As a result, we are setting our budget for the upcoming year at \$9.0M instead of \$9.6M. While this adjustment reflects our commitment to financial stewardship, our mission remains unchanged. The work God has called us to is still before us, and we know that through the regular, consistent pursuit of biblical giving, we can and will continue to make a difference in ways that far exceed our expectations.

Giving is an act of worship and trust, reflecting our belief that everything we have comes from God. As we continue to give our first and best to Him, we are participating in His divine work. produce of your entire harvest; then your barns will be completely filled, and your vats will overflow with new wine." When we prioritize generosity, we open our lives to the abundance of God's provision.

When we give faithfully, we not only impact others, but we also experience the deep fulfillment that comes from trusting God with our resources.
