If someone ever hurts you, you can tell! If something bad happens to you, you can tell! If something feels wrong or confusing, you can tell!



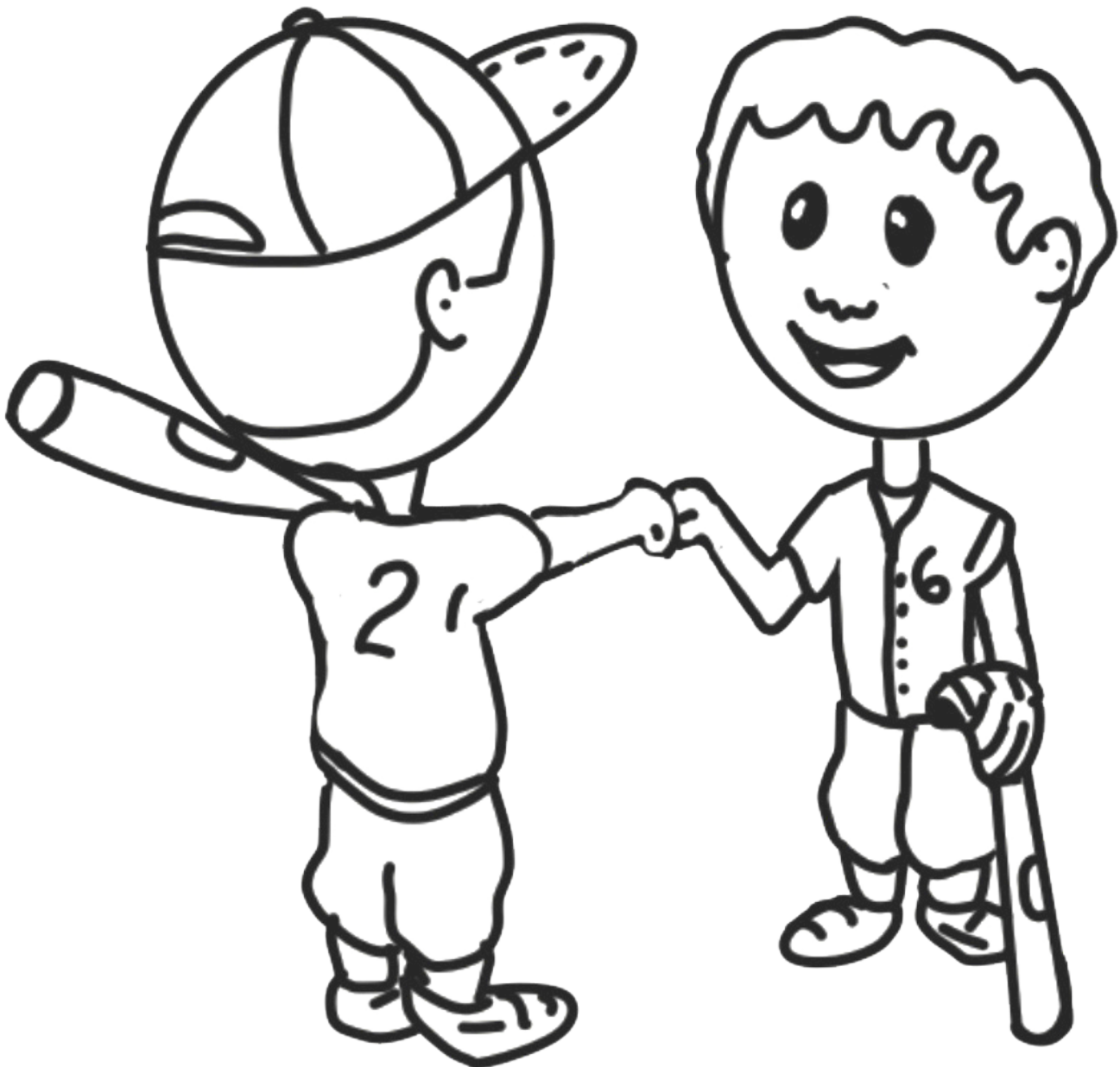
Can you count
