GROUP AGREEMENT

Authenticity: The heart that's well is a heart that tells (Eph. 4:2-3, Prov. 4:23)

I will be sincere in my words during group discussions so that they are a true reflection of my heart. I understand my contribution to conversations includes expressing difficult emotions and real struggles so that I may be known, be grown, and be loved.

Formation: Journey to Jesus until we are just like Jesus (Eph. 4:12-13, Gal. 4:19, 1 John 2:5-6)

I believe learning to abide in Jesus Christ is foundational to my spiritual journey with Jesus and I will strive daily to walk closer with Him. No matter the ups and downs in my journey, I choose to surrender daily to Jesus and live in biblical community so that I may be transformed into His likeness.

Priority: Commit to Community (Heb. 10:24-25, Col. 3:16)

I will prioritize meeting together with this group as often as it gathers unless I am sick or out of town.
