



KINGS AND KINGDOMS Week 7 - Legacy

MAIN OBJECTIVE: Assess your life through the lens of Godly leadership.

KEEP IN MIND: The goal is NOT to try and get through all the questions, but to have a meaningful discussion. Go through and think about which questions will land and spark the most conversation with those in your group.

INTRO: Summarize series

- Over the course of the summer series “Kings and Kingdoms,” we’ve seen a glimpse of God’s story through the life of David in 1 and 2 Samuel. While we reflect on David’s failures and success, as well as the hand of God’s redemption in all of it, we can look at our own lives to see how God is at work.

READ 2 Samuel 23:1-7

- What has stood out to you about David’s life through this series?
- What Godly leadership qualities can you identify in David?
- How have you seen God’s redemptive hand at work in David?
- Read verse 5 again. Considering David’s story, in what ways is God’s faithfulness reflected in his life?

DISCUSSION

- Where can you trace God’s faithfulness in your own life story?
- What victories have you experienced that you can celebrate?
- What areas of struggle have you seen God redeem for His glory and your good?

DIGGING DEEPER

- Do you view yourself as a leader? Why or why not?
- How can you ask God to transform your perspective to see the valuable leadership opportunities in your everyday mundane activities?
- What are the current spheres of influence God has given you?
- How can you demonstrate Godly leadership in those areas?
- What is one thing you can do this week to be faithful in the areas of influence God has given you?

CHALLENGE:

- Take time this week to write out your story. Try doing it through the lens of how you have seen God at work in your life. For example, using statements like: “God brought me to...”, “God provided me with...”, “God helped me...”, etc.
- Reflect prayerfully on your life story to this point. Praise God for your testimony and ask Him for clarity on how you can be faithful in this next season.



CLOSING PRAYER:

- Praise God for His faithfulness in the life of each person represented in the group.
- Ask God to continue using each person to be a Godly leader in any sphere of influence you are given.
