One-on-One Meetings

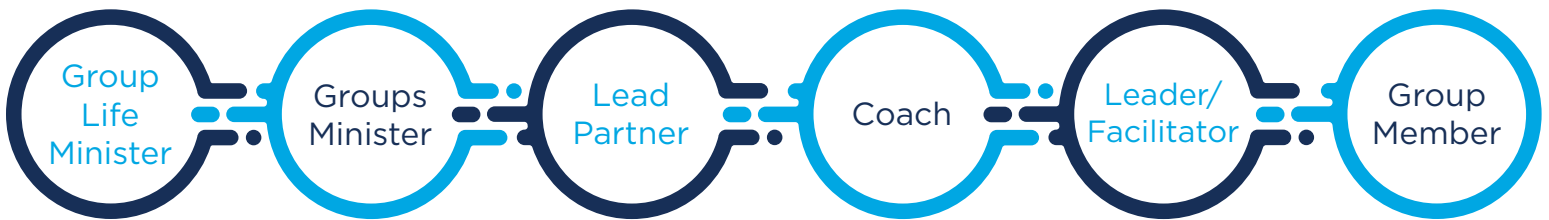
A private meeting with your coach or groups pastor to address specific group issues & to help you develop personally
