

When The Church Gets It Wrong

Week 4 - Thyatira

Revelation 2:18-29

SAY THIS: In the sermon this week we were taught that the church of Thyatira gave influence to the wrong teachers, letting lies shape their lives. Jesus warned them to hold onto the truth. As a body of believers we were encouraged to think deeply on the truth: *The voices we follow determine the future we live.*

ASK THIS:

Where does this truth connect with you? *The voices we follow determine the future we live.*

Group Discussion 30-45 minutes

HAVE SOMEONE READ: Revelation 2:18-29

What are some modern equivalents of “Jezebel-like” voices - teachings or influences that sound appealing but pull people away from truth?

In your experience how do the “voices we follow” practically shape the direction of your life?

Based on your own life experience, why is it often easier to drift into compromise than to stand firm in truth?

What voices have the most influence over your thinking right now (people, media, habits, internal narratives)?

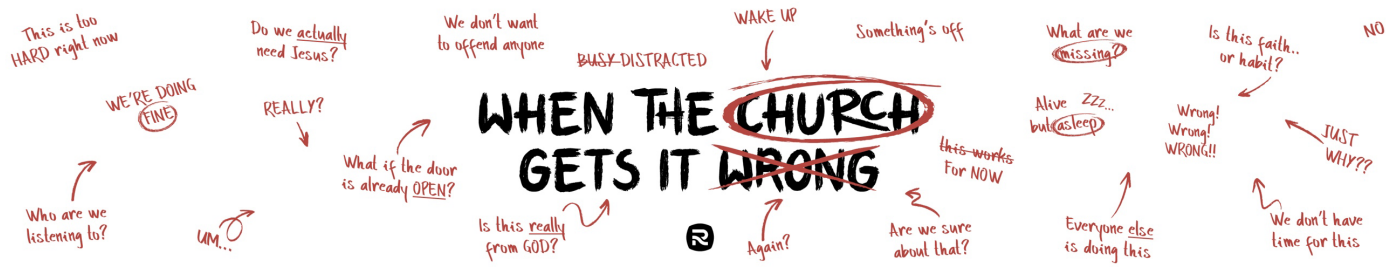
When have you felt the tension between what is true and what is easier or more appealing?

What is one specific lie or distortion that you need to reject right now?

DO THIS: As people share their responses pause the discussion and pray for God to release them from the lie or distortion

ASK THIS:

What is (1) practical step you can take this week to limit unhealthy influences or deepen healthy one?



How can this group help each other stay anchored in truth rather than drifting with culture?
